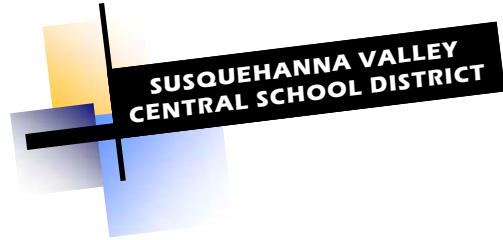

Who Is Eligible?

Any graduating senior from Susquehanna Valley who is pursuing further education may apply. The Susquehanna Valley Scholarship Foundation believes that all students should have the opportunity to pursue a higher education.

Who Funds The SV Scholarship Foundation?

Any individual, group, organization, or business may contribute. Gifts of all sizes are welcome, needed, appreciated and **are tax deductible!**

The annual phone-a-thon is our largest single source of funding. Beginning in kindergarten, student classes can start building their own individual class funds that are managed and awarded through SVSF. The chapter can also work with any contributor who may wish to establish an endowed award.

How Are Funds Distributed?

An awards committee determines distribution of funds based on scholarship, character, and service. With endowed funds, the contributor can establish criteria for their scholarship.

What is the Citizens' Scholarship Foundation of America?

The Susquehanna Valley Scholarship Foundation was formed in the Spring of 1999 as an affiliate of the Citizens Scholarship Foundation of America (CFSA). CFSA is a national nonprofit student aid service organization. Its purpose is to expand access to higher education by substantially increasing the amount of student aid from the private sector. One way CFSA pursues this mission is through the development and ongoing support of local scholarship foundations.

What is the Susquehanna Valley Scholarship Foundation?

Susquehanna Valley Scholarship Foundation Dollars for Scholars is managed by a Board of Trustees comprised of local citizens from many professions who believe in the potential of our youth and who have generously volunteered their time-there is no paid staff. The chapter is a tax-free organization. While the chapter enjoys the approval and encouragement of the Susquehanna Valley Central School District, the chapter administers its own funds and distributes awards.
