

**MINUTES of the
MAY 15, 2012
ANNUAL MEETING AND VOTE
of the
SUSQUEHANNA VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**
Held in the Senior High School Gymnasium
Conklin, New York, County of Broome

Mrs. Rosalynn Morgan, Chairperson of the meeting, welcomed those present and called the meeting to order at 11:55 a.m.

Mr. Richard Stank, Chief Inspector; the clerks and inspectors; Mr. Mark Gorgos, Legal Advisor to the Board; and Mrs. Morgan completed inspection of the voting machines.

Mrs. Morgan stated that the Board of Education designated Richard Stank as Chief Inspector of Election and Kenneth Goldberg as Alternate Chief Inspector. Mrs. Morgan asked for a motion allowing for appointment of additional inspectors of election and/or assistant clerks as necessary. Mrs. Kane made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Terry, allowing the Chair to appoint election officials as needed. Upon vote the motion was approved unanimously.

At 12:00 p.m. the polls were declared open by Mrs. Morgan.

At 8:55 p.m. Mrs. Morgan asked that anyone wanting to vote be in line to sign the poll list and complete their vote.

Everyone present completed their vote.

At 9:00 p.m. Mrs. Morgan declared the polls closed.

The poll list was tallied. Three books registered a total of 834.

The machine counters (#102, and #103) read a total of 833.

The number of votes cast:

Board Candidates:

Raymond Storm – 516 Joseph Walker – 517 Robert Strick – 186
Daniel Hogan – 164

There were four absentee ballots. The absentee ballots were opened and tallied. The results were:

Daniel Hogan – 1

Raymond Storm – 519 Joseph Walker – 519 Robert Strick – 186 Daniel Hogan – 165
(No other write-ins had more than four votes)

Raymond Storm, Joseph Walker and Robert Strick were elected as members of the Board of Education for a full term of three (3) years, commencing July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2015.

Mrs. Morgan adjourned the meeting at 10:04 p.m.
