News from the Guidance Office December 2023

College Applications

Seniors planning to go to college after high school should be diligently working on applications. Regular admission deadlines are early in January so students are encouraged to submit their applications **BEFORE** winter break. Students should give teachers and counselors at least two weeks to write letters of recommendation. It is important to communicate regularly with your counselor about where you are applying to ensure your transcript gets to the college in time.


Financial Aid

Filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is critical in determining how to pay for college. It allows students to find out which types and how much Federal Student Aid they may qualify for. If students are applying to a New York State school they should also be filing the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) application. Students and guardians should plan to submit the FAFSA and TAP by February 1! Shaunte Middleton from Binghamton University's Education Talent Search will be available to students that need help with this process.

How to Apply for Financial Aid:

- 1. Create an FSA ID.
- 2. Complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov .
- 3. Apply for TAP at www.tapweb.org.

Please reach out to the Counseling Office to setup an appointment with Ms. Middleton if you would like help completing this process.



SAT and ACT

There is still time for college-bound seniors to take the SAT or ACT. While some schools have a test-optional policy, there are schools and programs that require SAT or ACT scores. Both exams still have dates available!





Please be advised of the following important dates regarding your child's senior year deadlines for Yearbook submissions:

Senior Portraits

Schedule your **senior portrait** to ensure proper delivery to the school. Senior portraits are **DUE ASAP.** Failure to meet this deadline may result in an absence of a senior portrait. If you're unable to schedule a senior portrait, plan on using November 8 (our retake day) as an opportunity to get a senior photo. No costumes or props will be allowed for photos.

Portrait Requirements

Senior Portraits must be submitted electronically (CD, email jpeg, USB). The digital image must be a resolution of 300 dpi and the color mode must be RGB. The image should be sized to a 5x7 image to ensure proper clarity. The yearbook is an all-color book so please plan accordingly when choosing a photo for the yearbook. To maintain a consistent look, only head and shoulders will be in the yearbook photo. No costumes or props will be allowed for photos. Photos submitted should be in color and with a simple background. The SVHS yearbook reserves the right to refuse a photo not meeting specifications.

Senior portraits are due ASAP.

All electronic submissions are to be sent to dzietz@svsabers.org. If submitting in person, please see Mr. Zietz in room 22. Any picture received after the due dates listed are not guaranteed to be in the yearbook. It is the student's responsibility to check with their studio to see if the studio has submitted the senior portrait to Susquehanna Valley. Portraits from Sean Murphy Studios will automatically be sent to the school.

For the 2023-2024 school year, our yearbook photo contract is with Sean Murphy Studios. They offer free yearbook sessions in their Binghamton studio for all Susquehanna Valley seniors.
