## News from the Guidance Office November 2023



As previously published - the ASVAB will be given to all 10<sup>th</sup> grade students and some registered Jr./Sr. students on November 1, 2023 at 8 a.m. This aptitude test helps your child see how interests, abilities, and personal preferences match career opportunities. When taken in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade there is **NO** commitment to the military; it is strictly used as a career development tool and will aid in guiding student decisions regarding post high school plans. The test takes 3 hours and 15 minutes to complete online. Please assure your student arrives at school with a fully charged Chromebook (as they should everyday).



## Financial Aid Night

The guidance department will be offering an **IN-PERSON** Financial Aid Night for Seniors and their families on November 29, **at 6 p.m.** in the high school auditorium. Part of the college application process is to submit the <u>Free Application</u> for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This presentation will help students and families understand the types of financial aid available and how to submit the application. We highly encourage college-bound students to attend with their families. Richard Griffis, the Assistant Director of Financial Aid/Operations at SUNY Broome will be presenting.

Additionally, Shaunte Middleton (from Talent Search) continues to be available at SVHS from 9:45 a.m. to 1 p.m. on alternating Wednesdays to provide individualized assistance in completing the FAFSA and TAP applications. We continue to schedule college-bound students to meet with her, and welcome parents' participation. Please call the Counseling Office at 607-775-9115 if you would like to make an appointment.

### SAT and ACT

There is still time for college-bound seniors to take the SAT or ACT. While some schools have a test-optional policy, there are schools and programs that require SAT or ACT scores. Both exams have fall test dates!

- Khan Academy: This is a free, personalized, online study tool. Khan Academy has partnered with College Board to deliver a tailored guide to the SAT based on the student's PSAT results. If a student took the PSAT in October, they can link their results to Khan Academy!

SV is not a testing site, but our students can test at local high schools in the area such as Binghamton HS, Vestal HS or Maine-Endwell HS.






## **Sabers Art**





Please be advised of the following important dates regarding your child's senior year deadlines for Yearbook submissions:

## **Senior Portraits**

Schedule your **senior portrait** to ensure proper delivery to the school. Senior portraits are **due Friday, December 1**. Failure to meet this deadline may result in an absence of a sen ior portrait. If you're unable to schedule a senior portrait, plan on using November 8 (our retake day) as an opportunity to get a senior photo. No costumes or props will be allowed for photos.

## **Portrait Requirements**

Senior Portraits must be submitted electronically (CD, email jpeg, USB). The digital image must be a resolution of 300 dpi and the color mode must be RGB. The image should be sized to a 5x7 image to ensure proper clarity. The yearbook is an all-color book so please plan accordingly when choosing a photo for the yearbook. To maintain a consistent look, only head and shoulders will be in the yearbook photo. No costumes or props will be al lowed for photos. Photos submitted should be in color and with a simple background. The SVHS yearbook reserves the right to refuse a photo not meeting specifications.

## Senior portraits are due Friday, December 1.

All electronic submissions are to be sent to dzietz@svsabers.org. If submitting in person, please see Mr. Zietz in room 22. Any picture received after the due dates listed are not guaranteed to be in the yearbook. It is the student's responsibility to check with their studio to see if the studio has submitted the senior portrait to Susquehanna Valley. Portraits from Sean Murphy Studios will automatically be sent to the school.
