Please know you have our appreciation, compassion, and genuine respect for all you (and our students) are doing at home.

RTS PICK-UP / DROP OFF EVENT

On Monday, June 1st and Tuesday, June 2nd, we will have our RTS Family Pick-Up / Drop Off Event. It will take place from 3:00pm to 7:00pm both days.

On this day, students / families should enter the campus via Shaw Rd and drive around towards the front of the middle school building. I will meet each car there, get the names of all students you are picking up for, and direct you to pull up to the curb in front of RTS MS, where there will be three stopping locations. The first will be a collection area for all school related items needing to be turned in: RTS library books, classroom library books, calculators, textbooks, etc. Please check with your children to see if they have any of these at home. Emails for RTS Library books will be sent over the next week for students having them signed out currently. If any of these items were in a student's locker, these have already been grabbed during clean out.

The second will be a collection area for any musical instruments or technology that is in need of repair. Students are keeping both of these items over the summer months, so this is only items needing repairs / replacements. The third will be a pick up area, where the following will be brought out to the vehicle: locker items, P.E. locker items, awards and certificates, and Yearbooks. (If you had not ordered a Yearbook and would like to buy one, we will be selling them at this pick up area for \$20)

At no time will you need to step out of the vehicle. You will just be asked to efficiently move through the stages (with guidance from our staff). It is our hope to make this quick, efficient, effective, and easy for everyone involved.

The schedule is the following:

6/1, 3:00-4:00 --- Students with the last names A through C
6/1, 4:00-5:00 --- Students with the last names D through F
6/1, 5:00-6:00 --- Students with the last names G through J
6/1, 6:00-7:00 --- Students with the last names K through M
6/2, 3:00-4:00 --- Students with the last names N through Q
6/2, 4:00-5:00 --- Students with the last names R through U
6/2, 5:00-6:00 --- Students with the last names V through Z
6/2, 6:00-7:00 --- Any families that could not make their set time...

***If you are unable to make your scheduled time and also cannot make the 6/2 6:00pm-7:00pm open time, please email or call me (422-0248) and we will make alternate plans for you / your family.

LAST DAY OF THE SCHOOL YEAR

Pursuant to contractual stipulations and Executive Order 202.18, schools are required to work through scheduled breaks/vacations. This includes the Friday before the Memorial Day weekend (May 22). Memorial Day is a federal holiday, so the district will be closed on May 25.

We have determined that June 12th will be the last day of instruction for the SV School District. This is subject to change, however, if the Governor's office or the New York State Department of Education give further guidance.

Nonetheless, students will have the opportunity to turn in all work for the final checkpoint until Wednesday, June 17th.

Report cards will be issued to all families the week of June 22-26.
